**GRAVE WATCH:** We are asking members of the parish (men & women) to sign up for the “**Grave Watch**” for Holy Friday Evening & Holy Saturday, until 6 p.m. If you served at a grave watch position in past years, and want to continue, **see Fr. **PLEASE NOTE:** The church will be opened for prayer and meditation **all night Holy Friday and all day Holy Saturday until 6:00 p.m.** Men and women of our parish will stand watch at the grave of our Lord and Saviour throughout the night and day.

**VOLUNTEERS NEEDED** - As in previous on years, there will be a procession of Icons and Banners, etc. on Holy Friday evening and before Canons early Sunday morning. To expedite matters, Fr. Timothy and Keith Hay, our church President, are asking men and women of the parish to volunteer and sign up at the candle stand as to what they wish to carry in the procession. Please volunteer until all positions are filled.

**HOLY COMMUNION ON PASCHA!** - for all members who have taken General and/or Private Confession during the Lenten Season, you may receive Holy Communion on Pascha without Absolution.

**COLORED PASCHA EGGS** - Again, we would like to repeat the custom of sharing Pascha Eggs in our parish on Holy Pascha. Fr. Timothy asks that each Family bring one dozen dyed, hard-boiled eggs to church when they bring their basket to be blessed on Saturday at 5:00 p.m. or Sunday morning before Sunrise service at 6:00 a.m. Please use only pure food coloring as some dyes are not edible. These eggs will be blessed on Holy Pascha after Divine Liturgy and distributed to each person in church.
