**THE SEVEN SACRAMENTS – From Faith of Our Fathers**

*The Eastern Orthodox Church recognizes seven Sacraments. Through them the Church imparts the spiritual blessings of the Holy Spirit to believers. These holy acts, also known as the Seven Mysteries, include Baptism, Chrismation, Communion, Penance, Ordination, Matrimony and Extreme Unction with Oil.*

*The right to administer these sacraments was transmitted by the original Apostles to their successors, the Bishops, who in turn now transmit this right to the priests through one of the Sacraments, that of Ordination.*
