Timothy will ring the church toll bell (3 sets of 21 times) at 8:46 and 9:03 a.m. for the World Trade Center attacks, as well as 9:37 am for the Pentagon attack, and 10:03 am for the failed attack aimed at Washington DC that crashed in Shanksville, PA. Fr. Timothy will also serve a Parastas memorial after the ringing of church bells for those who lost their lives on that tragic day in 2001! I hope everyone will come to church early to pray, light candles and vigil lights, and spend time in moments of silence for them! **Let us not let terrorism win!**
